We hope that your **family** will join our parish family as we strive to love like Jesus and build God's kingdom here on **earth**.

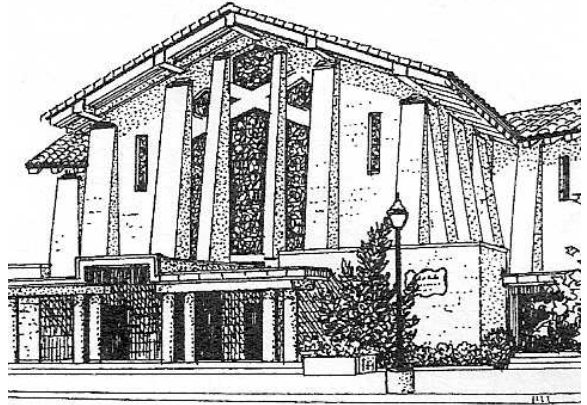

Sacraments

Reconciliation: Saturdays 3:30-4:30 pm
(Contact a priest if you wish to receive the sacrament on another day.)

Baptism: Baptisms are normally held on the second and fourth Sundays at 1:00 pm. Arrangements should be made at least three months in advance. Parents must attend baptismal instruction before the baptism of their child. This preparation may be done before the birth of the child.

Marriage: Arrangements should be made by the prospective bride and groom at least six months in advance. The parish marriage preparation program is required of all couples.

Communion in the Home: Eucharistic Ministers are available to bring Communion to those who are unable to attend Mass. Please call the Parish Center.

Anointing of the Sick: This sacrament is for those who are elderly, seriously sick or scheduled for surgery. Please call the Parish Center. For those in the hospital, contact the chaplain's office at that hospital.

FAITH FORMATION AT ST. PIUS

Children's Liturgy of the Word

This takes place every week during the 9:30am Mass, except during Children's Masses. I am grateful for the committed adults who are involved in this important ministry to our parish children. This is a wonderful way to become involved at St. Pius parish and support our children as they learn about Jesus through the readings. We provide three age groups: 3-5 years of age, K-2nd grade, and 3rd - 5th grade. This requires 3 volunteers per week. Parents are welcome to visit with their children.
